Age (As on 01.08.2026):

Minimum: 20 years

Maximum: 28 years

i.e. A candidate must have been born not earlier than 02.08.1998
and not later than 01.08.2006 (both dates inclusive)

Relaxation of Upper age limit

Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe	5 years
Other Backward Classes (Non-Creamy Layer)	3 years
Persons With Benchmark Disabilities as defined under “The Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016”	10 years
Ex-Servicemen (ESM) / Disabled Ex-Servicemen (DESM)	actual period of service rendered in the defence forces + 3 years (8 years for Disabled Ex-Servicemen belonging to SC/ST) subject to a maximum age limit of 50 years
Widows, divorced women and women legally separated from their husbands who have not remarried	Age concession upto the age of 35 years for General/EWS, 38 years for OBC and 40 years for SC/ST candidates

Educational Qualifications (As on 21.08.2026):

A Degree (**Graduation**) in any discipline from a University recognised by the Govt. Of India or any equivalent qualification recognized as such by the Central Government. The candidate must possess valid Mark-sheet / Degree Certificate that he/ she is a graduate on the day he / she registers and indicate the percentage of marks obtained in Graduation while registering online.

The candidates applying for vacancies of a particular **State/UT**, should be **proficient** in (**reading, writing, speaking and understanding**) the specified / opted **local language** of that State/UT (mentioned in the list provided for each Sate/ UT as per Annexure III).

Computer Literacy

Operating and working knowledge in computer systems is mandatory i.e. candidates should have Certificate/Diploma/Degree in computer operations/Language/ should have studied Computer / Information Technology as one of the subjects in the High School/College/Institute.

Application Fees & Intimation Charges

Application Fees/ Intimation Charges [Online payment from **01.08.2026 to 21.08.2026**, both dates inclusive] shall be as follows:

- Rs. 175/- (inclusive of GST) for SC/ST/PwBD/ESM/DESM candidates.
- Rs. 850 /- (inclusive of GST) for all others

Bank Transaction charges for Online Payment of application fees/ intimation charges will have to be borne by the candidate.

Candidates have to qualify in each of the three tests by securing cut-off marks to be decided by IBPS. Adequate number of candidates in each category as decided by IBPS depending upon requirements will be shortlisted for Online Main examination.

Penalty for Wrong Answers (Applicable to both – Online Preliminary and Online Main Examination)

There will be penalty for wrong answers marked in the Objective Tests. For each question for which a wrong answer has been given by the candidate **one fourth or 0.25** of the marks assigned to that question will be deducted as penalty to arrive at corrected score. If a question is left blank, i.e. no answer is marked by the candidate, there will be no penalty for that question.

Cut-off Score (Online Main examination)

Each candidate will be required to obtain a minimum score in each test of Online Main Examination and also a minimum total score to be considered for further process. Depending on number of the State/ UT wise vacancies available, cut-offs will be decided and candidates will be considered for provisional allotment. Prior to the completion of provisional allotment process scores obtained in the Online Main Examination will not be shared with the candidates. Decision of IBPS in shortlisting and provisional allotment shall be final.

MARKS OBTAINED IN THE ONLINE MAIN EXAMINATION ONLY WILL BE CONSIDERED FOR FINAL MERIT LISTING.

Local Language Proficiency Test (LLPT)

The candidates applying for vacancies of a particular State/UT, should be proficient in (reading, writing, speaking and understanding) the specified / opted local language of that State/UT.

- Candidate has to opt for ONE language at the time of online application for local language test from the list provided for each State/ UT as per Annexure III.
- Candidates who produce 10th standard or above mark sheet/ certificate evidencing having studied the specified/ opted local language will not be required to undergo the language test.
- The test will be conducted after qualifying the Online Main examination/ Provisional Allotment but before joining the Bank.
- The test for knowledge of specified/ opted local language will be conducted as a part of selection process by an independent body or by the Bank and will be marks based and qualifying in nature.
- Candidates who fail to qualify this test will not be offered appointment and will be disqualified from the process.

Pre - Examination Training (PET)

Pre-Examination Training may be arranged in Online Mode to a limited number of candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste/ Scheduled Tribes/ Other Backward Classes/ Minority Communities/ Ex-Servicemen/ Persons with Benchmark Disabilities. All eligible candidates who opt for and wish to avail of Pre-Examination Training should fill in the relevant column in the ON-LINE APPLICATION. By merely attending the Pre-Examination Training, no candidate acquires any right to be selected in any of the Participating Banks mentioned.

PROVISIONAL ALLOTMENT

The total marks allotted for **Online Main Examination** are **200**. Marks will be converted **out of 100** for **Provisional allotment**. A candidate should qualify in the Online Main Examination and be sufficiently high in the merit to be considered for subsequent provisional allotment process, details of which will be made available subsequently on official IBPS website **www.ibps.in**.
